New Constitution

The changes made were largely to comply with the new Act such as maintaining a minimum membership of 10, complying with procedures around AGMs, a disputes resolution process, disclosure requirements, more specificity around Board members and consent, and managing conflicts of interest. The constitution has been lodged and we are now re-registered to comply with the Act.
