- Short Term Storage is available for a minimum of 1 week, and a **maximum of 4 weeks** anytime between **1 February until 10am on 1 December at the latest**.
- Weekly storage fee - \$30.00 including GST, payable in advance.
- For storage less than one week we still charge a minimum of one week. We don't calculate a daily rate.
- We reserve the right to review and increase fees at any time.
- You can arrange to have your vehicle moved to Long Term Storage at end of short-term storage contract. Refer to Long Term Storage Terms and conditions.
- If you are collecting your vehicle from storage, please do this during business hours and let us know so we can record this against your storage account. Moves outside of business hours are allowed with prior arrangement. No person other than the owner is authorized to collect the vehicle from storage.
- Insurance & Liability: We recommend that vehicle owners maintain full coverage insurance during the storage period. Tāhuna Beach Holiday Park assumes no liability

for loss, damage, or destruction to the vehicle or its contents, due to collision, fire, theft, or otherwise. We do accept liability for damage directly attributable to the negligence of Tāhuna Beach Holiday Park.

- Vehicles (caravans and campers) being removed from storage onto a site or for use outside the park must have on display
 - Current NZTA registration
 - Current warrant of fitness
 - Current electrical warrant of fitness
- Please let us know if you are moving your vehicle from storage permanently and wish to cancel your storage booking.
